

## **ETHICS COMMITTEE**

<u>Purpose:</u> The Ethics Committee is responsible for educating the membership about the ethical standards held by the dental profession and organized dentistry

## Primary Responsibilities:

- To ensure communication of ethical standards established by the CDA and the ADA.
- Provide information to help member dentists comply with the Code of Ethics.
- Review, address complaints submitted by members or patients that relate the Code of Ethics. Unresolved issues will be reported, in writing, to the CDA board of directors.
- · Provide articles of interest for The Bridge

<u>Time Commitment/Meeting Schedule:</u> Depending upon the complexity of any given ethics case(s), virtual meetings or conference calls will be called by the chair. All committee meetings are scheduled with the SFDS office.

<u>Composition and Terms of Office</u>: Is composed of at least 3 members appointed by the president and subject to approval of the Board of Directors. The committee Chair serves a two (2) year term renewable for a maximum of three (3) consecutive terms. The executive director attends all ethics committee meetings.

## Special Qualifications/Skills:

- To serve on the committee, volunteers must be five-year (5) members of the association
- Committee members are selected for their ability to maintain objectivity, discretion, confidentiality, and understanding
- Committee members are not compensated or placed in a position to received financial gain from service on the committee
